With the new year here, it's a great time to reflect on what your Moose Legion accomplished in 2024 with your help.



Physically, the Moose Legion began renovations on the horseshoe pits and built a drink rail around the Tiki bar. We've purchased new audio equipment for the dining room, cornhole boards, new storage and shelter solutions, and hats and shirts for conferred members.

Charitably, we donated to Charlotte Warriors Youth Football, Southwest Florida Honor Flight, the Manatee #58 Golf Tournament, the North Port Golf Tournament, toys for Breakfast with Santa, and the Patriot Riders. We also initiated the collection of backpacks and school supplies for Toys for Tots. Additionally, individuals benefited as we donated towards a member's liver transplant and assisted another member with expenses incurred after the death of a loved one.

In terms of fun and frolic, the Moose Legion paid out over \$19,000 in cash, drinks, and bottles of alcohol for the football games. While we haven't had a jackpot winner for the Ace of Spades yet this year, we've still paid out over \$2,500 in prizes, and the jackpot currently stands at over \$4,500.
