### Don't miss the Florida Disaster Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday when shopping for hurricane and emergency supplies. This tax free week takes place over 14 days:

On these dates, you can purchase qualifying items free of Florida state and local sales tax:

- Portable generators priced at \$750 or less
- Portable self-powered radios, 2-way radios, or weather band radios priced at \$50 or less
- Tarps or other flexible waterproof sheeting priced at \$50 or less
- Ground anchor systems or tie-down kits priced at \$50 or less
- AA, C, D, 6-Volt, or 9-Volt batteries priced at \$30 or less
- Non-electric coolers and ice chests priced at \$30 or less
- Gas, LP gas, diesel fuel, or kerosene containers priced at \$25 or less
  - Portable self-powered flashlights, candles, lanterns, or other light sources priced at \$20 or less
- Reusable ice priced at \$10 or less

Any sales made within an airport, entertainment complex, theme park, or public lodging establishment do NOT qualify for this tax exemption.
